St. Louis and Stuttgart, Germany signed a formal Sister City agreement in 1960, thus making Stuttgart the first St. Louis Sister City. Stuttgart is the capital of the German State of Baden-Württemberg and also the largest city in southwestern Germany. Like St. Louis, it has an important inland harbor, an international airport, major railroad junction, industrial and manufacturing centers, educational and cultural institutions. The 1,100 acres of vineyards within the city limits make Stuttgart a major wine producer. It is also an orchard community with almost eight million fruit trees within 20 miles of city hall.

Stuttgart is famous for automakers Porsche and Mercedes. The city also boasts a world class opera and ballet, four renowned orchestras, several universities and major medical centers. The Swabian Cannstatter Folk Festival is held at the end of September on the banks of the river Neckar.

We offer members a variety of special cultural, social, economic and sporting events. There is an opportunity to meet visitors from Stuttgart and to provide St. Louis hospitality.

Aside from its special events, St. Louis-Stuttgart is actively involved in the Sister Cities' mission. In the area of education we are helping shape tomorrow's global leaders by providing scholarships for study abroad to high school and university students.
